AYU0190) to increase intake capacity of undergraduate (BAMS) course from 60 to 100 seats and grant of conditional Permission for 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 28 seats in 05 PG courses namely (i) Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana-06 seats, (ii) Shalya Tantra-06 seats, (iii) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (iv) Stree Rog Prasuti Tantra-05 seats and (v) Balrog-05 seats for the academic session 2021-22 under section 28/29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder-reg.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provisions of National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government notified that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. In view of the above the Central Government constituted the Autonomous Boards with effect from 11th June, 2021 and as per regulation 59 (2) of The National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020, Medical standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 and the rules and regulations made thereunder shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made thereunder. Further, the provision of concerned regulations which are inconsistent with the provision of NCISM ACT 2020 shall not be applicable.

1. I am directed to refer to your application vide dated **31.08.2020** forwarded by GOI vide letter No. **L-14013/06/2020-EP (1) Dated 21.09.2020**, on the subject cited above and to say that physical verification of available facilities of teaching and practical training **to increase intake capacity of undergraduate (BAMS) course from 60 to 100 seats from the academic session 2021-22**. Therefore, as per direction of competent authority on the basis of Part-I visitation proforma submitted by **Ashvin Rural Ayurved College, Manchi Hill, Ashvi B.K.Ashvi BK, Tal. Sangamner, Distt. Ahmednagar-413714, Maharashtra (Inst. ID. AYU0190)** as well as indemnity bond, affidavit & details of teaching, non-teaching and hospital staff submitted by the said college were examined and vide Medical Assessment and Rating Board letter ref. no 3-3/2021-Ay.(51) Dated 24.09.2021, LOI (letter of Intent) has been issued to your college **to increase intake capacity of undergraduate (BAMS) course from 60 to 100 seats from the academic session 2021-22**.

2. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) had carried out an inspection of the institution on **22.10.2021** for Letter of

Permission (LoP) and permission under 13C to assess the available facilities of teaching and practical training for conducting UG & PG courses and to verify the compliance of shortcomings informed by the NCISM under section 28/29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.

3. Further, On examining the same, certain deficiencies have been observed and therefore, under section 28/29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, an opportunity of hearing was granted to the college on **06.12.2021** to present the case through virtual mode.
4. On examining the same it is found that the College is fulfilling the notified and approved criteria for Issuing Letter of Permission (LoP) **to increase in intake capacity of undergraduate (BAMS) course from 60 to 100 seats**, for the Academic Session 2021-22 onward.
5. Further vide commission letter ref no. **3-3/2021-Ay. (51). dated 07.12.2021** letter has been sent to the college to furnish fixed security deposit worth rupees 50 Lakhs in favour of National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine, in response of the same college has furnished the fixed security deposit in favour of the National Commission fund for Indian system of Medicine through **RTGS/NEFT/UTR. No. MAHBR52021120810993463 dated 08.12.2021 of rupees 50 Lakhs transferred by Bank of Maharashtra, Sangamner (for a period of five years).**
6. Further, in view of above, the college has been assessed on the basis of Relaxation policy issued by the Ministry of AYUSH and on examining in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for undergraduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016, provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, it is found that the College is fulfilling notified and approved criteria **to increase in intake capacity of UG (BAMS) course & Granting Conditional Permission for UG (BAMS) course and 05 PG courses for A.Y. 2021-22.**
7. Therefore, it has been decided by the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) to issue Letter of Permission (LoP) to the **Principal, Ashvin Rural Ayurved College, Manchi Hill, Ashvi B.K.Ashvi BK, Tal. Sangamner, Distt. Ahmednagar-413714, Maharashtra (Inst. ID. AYU0190) to increase in intake capacity of undergraduate (BAMS) course from 60 to 100 seats from the academic session 2021-22 under Section 28/29 of NCISM Act 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, and grant conditional Permission for 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 28 seats in 05 PG courses namely (i) Rasashastra & Bhaishajya Kalpana-06 seats, (ii) Shalya Tantra-06 seats, (iii) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (iv) Stree Rog Prasuti Tantra-05 seats and (v) Balrog-05 seats** for the academic session 2021-22 under section 28/29 of the NCISM 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder, subject to following conditions:
 - I. The conditions as specified in the Undertaking/Indemnity bond submitted by the college.
 - II. The college shall submit an undertaking in form of affidavit duly notarized within one month from the date of issue of the letter, explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying fee same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provident Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
8. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 UG (BAMS) seats and 15% of 28 PG seats shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2021-22 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.

9. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
10. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
11. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2021 to get permission for the session 2022-23:
 - (i) all the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
 - (ii) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
 - (iii) all the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto;
 - (iv) all the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016 for grant of permission to PG courses.
12. This permission **to increase in intake capacity of undergraduate (BAMS) course from 60 to 100 seats** as stated above for the first admitted batch of 2021-22 session, will be valid till such time as the first batch of students admitted against these courses appear for the first final examination of the said courses and at that time, the College authorities may take up the matter for recognition of the qualifications under Section 35 of the NCISM Act, 2020.
13. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission matter from the academic session 2022-23.
