

6. Outcomes of the Seminar

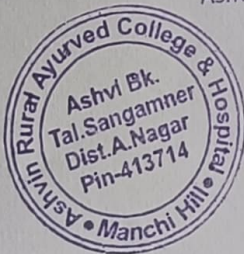
- Enhanced knowledge about medicinal plants among participants.

- Strengthened academic interest in Ayurveda.




